ACS/Mellon Bank Updates Custodian Name Change and New Investment Option

Custodian Name Change

The name of Mellon as the custodian of the ACS/Mellon HSA Solution changed to The Bank of New York Mellon on or about July 1, 2008. While at this time, the name change does not affect the "ACS/Mellon HSA Solution" brand name, some forms and materials will change to include The Bank of New York Mellon wherever Mellon Trust of New England, N.A. was mentioned.

Account holders will receive communications about the name change with their upcoming statements. This change should be mostly transparent to account holders, as there is no change to their transit, routing, or account numbers.

The ACS/Mellon Welcome Kit posted on the Brokers and Agents section of www.carefirst.com will be updated soon and most ACS/Mellon forms have already been revised accordingly.

New Integrated Investment Platform

Starting in October 2008, ACS/Mellon will offer a new HSA investment platform that will provide a seamless and affordable way to invest for the long-term. Offering a large variety of mutual fund families, this enhanced platform will provide an easy-to-use online environment with access to investment accounts 24 hours a day, seven days a week.

ACS|Mellon will communicate to all account holders about the move to this new investment platform through a series of statement stuffers starting this month.
